## Nordstrom Rack To Open At Janss Marketplace In Thousand Oaks, Calif.

SEATTLE, Dec. 3, 2013 /PRNewswire/ -- Seattle-based [Nordstrom, Inc.](#) (NYSE: JWN) announced today plans to further expand its Los Angeles-area presence with the addition of a [Nordstrom Rack](#) at Janss Marketplace in Thousand Oaks, Calif. The approximately 40,000-square-foot store is scheduled to open in fall 2015. The Rack location at Janss Marketplace is a development by [Seritage Realty Trust](#), a division of Sears Holdings Corporation.

Nordstrom has operated a full-line store approximately one mile from the new Rack location at The Oaks since 2008.

The new, two-story Nordstrom Rack will occupy a portion of the existing Sears location at Janss Marketplace with entrances accessible to parking on level one and to the shopping center on level two. Sears will continue to occupy an anchor position on the primary floor of the existing store.

"We are very proud to welcome Nordstrom Rack as an important co-anchor in our redevelopment of Janss Marketplace along with a fully redesigned Sears store and other high-quality retailers," said David Lukes, chief executive officer of Seritage Realty Trust. "This property represents a dominant market position and will continue to serve members and customers in the years ahead."
