The first Nordstrom Rack opened as a clearance center in the lower-level of the downtown Seattle Nordstrom store in 1973. The first stand-alone Nordstrom Rack opened in 1983 in Clackamas, Ore. As Nordstrom expanded to other parts of the country, Nordstrom Rack stores followed.

MERCHANDISE:

Nordstrom Rack carries merchandise from Nordstrom stores and Nordstrom.com, as well as specially purchased items from many of the top brands sold at Nordstrom.
